Dear Camp Lighthouse Champions,

This past year has been an amazing year of “going deeper not wider” with our incredible campers and summer staff. Every year, we lean further into this core value and sit back as the Lord produces fruit from that approach. The fruit we saw this past year was evident in the spiritual depth displayed during our retreats and summer camp season. This was especially clear in watching staff lead their own morning Bible studies and in the constant infusion of spiritual, Christ-centered conversations into everything we do.

One example of this happened when a camper told his counselor that he wanted to receive Jesus. The two of them sat down with one of our college-aged support staff to pray and celebrate this important step in the camper’s faith. This moment had a profound impact on the two summer staff. The spiritual impact extends to our staff as well, as we celebrated the baptisms for four of our summer staff to end the month of June.

Lastly, three counselors served on our team this past year whom began their Camp Lighthouse journeys as campers, and we had seven campers who came to summer camp for their 5th time! These are just two examples that demonstrate the beautiful on-going relationships that we get to enjoy with our campers and counselors. Retreat Season | July 2025 - May 2026

- 30 retreats throughout the year including 17 camper retreats, 11 church retreats, and 2 staff retreats
- 65 of our 73 summer camp staff served on at least one of our camper retreats this past year
- 473 kids and teens attended camper retreats with 1,624 participants and volunteers across all 30 retreats

Summer Camp | June 2026

- 131 campers came to one of our 4 weeks of summer camp from 7 different Camper Agency Partners
- 73 high school and college aged leaders served on our summer staff team with most serving multiple weeks
- 47 adult volunteers provided medical services, meal preparation, program support, and transportation



Operational Highlights

- Thanks to the generosity of North Georgia Grading, we were able to fix our lake for \$100K rather than the estimated \$950K without their incredible support
- Thanks to you, we raised \$480,733 to see our ministry and mission fully funded for the 2025-2026 fiscal year
